Community Character Workshop "Raw Data"

5.18.23



The Recodify Cashiers project is an effort to update the development regulations that apply in the Cashiers Commercial District. These standards are found in Section 9.3 of the Jackson County Unified Development Ordinance (or "UDO"). The standards in the UDO address what kinds of land uses may be permitted in what areas, how those uses must be configured, and the procedure used to establish those uses.

Task 3, Community Character, involved a series of meetings and presentations designed to identify and better define the Cashiers community character. The purpose of this exercise is to create additional community character review criteria for new development. New development would be required to be consistent with the codified community character criteria.

On Tuesday, May 9, 2023, the consulting team and County staff conducted a public workshop to identify locations in Cashiers that were good examples of the established community character as well as a pair of ranking exercises of existing buildings and descriptive terms related Cashiers. Community residents had another opportunity to share their thoughts about community character at a table hosted by the County at the Green Market on Wednesday May 10.

This document includes copies of the "raw data" that was collected at these two efforts. Raw data means copies of the maps, ranking pages, and term selection pages used by County staff and the consulting team during the public workshop and Green market table. This document includes just the raw data and does not include any summary or analysis. A summary presentation to the community was conducted on Thursday, May 11, 2023, and a copy of that presentation is on the project webpage (<u>www.recodifycashiers.com</u>). This data will be incorporated with other feedback in the preparation of a unified document defining and providing examples of Cashiers community Character as part of project Task 4, Annotated Outline.

Community Character Workshop Exercise 1: Mapping

Community Character Workshop Exercise 2: Building Ranking

The second exercise of the community character workshop conducted on Tuesday, May 9 was for each of the four tables of participants to work together and review eight pages of different buildings and site features in Cashiers. The task was to examine each of the 48 images and assign a rank from 1 to 3 for each image. A ranking of 1 means that the image depicts a building or site feature that is not very consistent with the table participant's ideas of what is the Cashiers community character. A ranking of 3 means that the image depicts a building or site feature that is consistent with the Cashiers community character.
